The Result of the Electricity Saving Measures for the Summer 2011

INPEX CORPORATION (INPEX) announced that it had successfully reduced electricity consumption by approximately 40% in the summer 2011 at all of its business facilities where electricity is supplied by Tokyo Electric Power Company and Tohoku Electric Power Company.

The Electricity saving measures described below were implemented at all of INPEX business facilities in line with the Japanese government directions for electricity consumption for July to September 2011.

Operation Sites

- Used in-house power generation to reduce the outside power supply.
- Changed operation hours avoiding usual peak hour operation.
- Replaced some of the operational equipment to those of energy saving types.

Offices etc.

- > Set the airconditioned room temperature two degrees Celcius higher than the original settings.
- Reduced the level of illumination, and introduced the LED lights.
- Minimized the standby electricity of personal computers.

INPEX will continue to implement power saving initiatives.
