Visit of Trainees from Central Asian and Caucasus Countries

On 28 January 2010, INPEX CORPORATION received a group of trainees who were with the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) program for young foreigners. Development Association for Youthworkers played a coordinator role of the program.

The group of 22 trainees was mainly comprised of young governmental officials from 5 countries of Georgia, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan and Turkmenistan. As they are expected to be officials in the public sector who are responsible for the development of their countries, they learned a wide range of Japanese management systems including policy, administration, economy, industry and enterprise during the training program.
