

INPEX Awarded Permit to Explore Block WA-504-P (Exploration Block) Offshore Western Australia

TOKYO, JAPAN - <u>INPEX CORPORATION</u> (INPEX) is pleased to announce today that INPEX Browse E&P Pty Ltd (INPEX Browse), a subsidiary, was awarded an exploration permit for Release Area WA-504-P (the Block). INPEX Browse will hold a 40% participating interest in the Block while Santos will hold a 60% participating interest serving as Operator.

This is the 11th block in which INPEX holds exploration permits or retention leases in the vicinity of the Ichthys gas-condensate field, where INPEX as Operator is developing the world-scale Ichthys LNG Project. Exploration of the Block will help INPEX maximise the potential value of the Ichthys LNG Project, in line with the company's initiatives.



Location of WA-504-P

The Block is located approximately 500 km north-northeast of Broome, off the coast of the state of Western Australia. It covers an area of 83 km2 where the water is approximately 400 m deep.

The Block is situated northwest of large gas reserves that have been discovered,

including the Ichthys gas-condensate field as well as the Prelude and Concerto gas

fields.

The exploration permit covering the Block follows the WA-502-P exploration permit also

awarded to INPEX Browse following the 2013 Australian Offshore Petroleum Acreage

Release, as announced on 16 May 2014.
