## INPEX to Strengthen Natural Gas Business Operations in Japan through Internal Reorganization

**TOKYO, JAPAN** - <u>INPEX CORPORATION</u> (INPEX) announced today that it will reorganize its natural gas business operations in Japan by establishing the "Domestic Energy Supply & Marketing Division" through the reorganization of its existing "Oil & Gas Business Division 2" and "Gas Supply & Infrastructure Division," effective April 1, 2017.

This reorganization reflects the company's response to changes in the natural gas business environment in Japan, including growing competition in the Japanese natural gas market triggered by the full liberalization of the gas retail market that will come into effect in April this year. The reorganization is designed to allow INPEX to respond more flexibly and productively to this changing environment and strengthen its natural gas business operations in Japan.

INPEX has actively pursued the three growth targets outlined in the company's Medium-to Long-Term Vision announced in 2012, including the continuous enhancement of E&P activities, the strengthening of its gas supply chain and the reinforcement of renewable energy initiatives.

In relation to the strengthening of its gas supply chain, INPEX aims to achieve a domestic gas supply volume of 2.5 billion cubic meters per year in the early 2020s, and 3 billion cubic meters per year in the longer-term. To realize this growth target, INPEX has been enhancing its domestic natural gas supply infrastructure including starting operations at Naoetsu LNG Terminal in December 2013 and extending its natural gas trunk pipeline network with the operational startup of the Toyama Line in October 2016.

- 1. Establishing the "Domestic Energy Supply & Marketing Division" through the reorganization of the "Oil & Gas Business Division 2" and "Gas Supply & Infrastructure Division"
  - (1) The objective of the reorganization is to deploy business strategy by looking down overall domestic gas business under single division Domestic Energy Supply &



Marketing Division from existing two divisions (Oil & Gas Business Division 2 and Gas Supply and Infrastructure Division) and to strengthen its overall sales and business planning structures.

- (2) The Domestic Energy Supply & Marketing Division will consist of the following subdivisions:
  - Strategy Planning & Coordination Unit
  - Gas Marketing Unit
  - Oil Products Marketing Unit
  - Naoetsu Administration Unit
  - Naoetsu LNG Terminal
  - Gas Supplying Unit
  - HSE Unit
- (3) The effective date of reorganization April 1, 2017
- (4) Change of title of Executive Officers and General Manager appointments, effective April 1, 2017.
