Electricity Saving Measures for the Summer 2011

INPEX CORPORATION announced that it would save electricity in order to meet possible electricity shortage this summer in Japan. INPEX plans to reduce electricity consumption by more than 30% than the level last year, at the operation sites and the offices in the areas where electricity is supplied by Tokyo Electric Power Company and the Tohoku Electric Power Company.

■ Operation Sites

- Reduce outsourced electricity supply by using in-house power generation.
- Try not to carry out operations that use outsourced electricity at peak hours .
- Replace some of the operational equipment to those of energy saving types.

■ Offices etc.

- Set the airconditioned room temperature at two degrees Celcius higher than the original settings.
- Reduce light, and introduce the LED lights.
- Minimize the standby electricity of personal computers.
