The Result of Electricity Saving Measures for Summer 2012

INPEX CORPORATION (INPEX) is pleased to announce that just as last year INPEX reduced electricity consumption by as high as approximately 39% from the year 2010 at all of its business facilities where electricity is supplied by Tokyo Electric Power Company, Tohoku Electric Power Company and Chubu Electric Power Company in the summer 2012.

The Electricity saving measures described below were implemented at all of INPEX business facilities in line with the Japanese government promotions for electricity saving for July to September 2012.

Operation Sites

- Used in-house power generation to reduce the power supply from outside.
- > Changed operation hours avoiding usual peak hour operation.
- Replaced some of the operational equipment to those of energy saving types.

Offices etc.

- Set the airconditioned room temperature two degrees Celcius higher than the original settings.
- Reduced the level of illumination, and introduced the LED lights.
- Minimized the standby electricity of personal computers.

INPEX will continue to implement power saving initiatives.
