Electricity Saving Measures for Winter 2013

INPEX CORPORATION (INPEX) has been conducting various electricity saving measures since the summer 2011 throughout its all offices and operational sites. Upon the initiatives recently taken by the Japanese Government, INPEX will make further efforts to save and reduce electricity consumption during this winter season (December 2013 to March 2014) by supplying electricity to grid power and using in-house power generation for INPEX business facilities where electricity is supplied by Tokyo Electric Power Company, Tohoku Electric Power Company and Chubu Electric Power Company.

Operation Sites

- Reduce outsourced electricity supply by using in-house power generation of Koshijihara plant (natural gas production plant).
- Supply electricity to grid power by using excess capacity of in-house power generation of Koshijihara plant and Koshijihara electric generation plant.

Offices etc.

- Reduce light and turn off the lights at lunch hours and after office hours.
- Minimize the standby electricity of personal computers.
- Reduce outsourced electricity supply by using renewable energy such as solar power and wind power.

INPEX continues to enlighten employees on the importance of electricity saving by informing them of the electricity consumption at company's operation sites and offices and introducing electricity saving measures at home.
